Adults, who have a high school diploma or GED, can become prepared to apply and take the National Council Licensing Examination for Practical Nursing (NCLEX-PN).

APPLICATION DEADLINE

Applications should be on file no later than 4:00 p.m. on Thursday, Apr 27, 2017, for consideration for the Class of 2018, beginning in August 2017.

LENGTH OF PROGRAM

Ten (10) months/41 sequential weeks, divided into three 10-week terms and one 11-week term from August through June.

PROGRAM HOURS / CONTACT INFORMATION

The Monty Tech Practical Nursing Program provides 1,230 instructional clock hours during its 41 week sequential academic year. Monday through Thursday (evenings) 3:30 to 9:50 p.m. and every other weekend, Saturday/Sunday (days, schedule fluctuates)

TUITION REFUNDS

If the student is **not** receiving federal or state funding and withdraws from the Program, the following plan for refund of tuition will be followed: **Before the first official class - 100%; After the first class, but before the 10th class meeting - 75%; After the 10th class meeting, but before the 30th class meeting - 50%; After the 30th class meeting - NO REFUND**

The TEAS test was developed in 1999 to measure basic essential skills in the academic content areas of reading, math, science, English and language usage. When creating an account on the ATI website you will assign yourself a username and password. **You will need to bring this information with you the evening of the exam.** The exam can only be taken twice to achieve a passing score in each content area. If the exam is taken outside of Monty Tech, but within the state of Massachusetts, all four sections must be taken.
